

Tee-Line Turf

STI Tee-Line Turf is a great alternative to maintaining a natural grass tee area. Tee-Line Turf looks, feels, and reacts like real grass and will also accept tees and allow the ball to set up naturally. With the sand and rubber infill the tee area is able to be used on a daily basis. No more moving and reseeding the teeing area at your range.

Tee-Line Turf is also a great replacement for those tee box areas that can not maintain a real grass surface. No irrigation, chemicals or sunlight is needed.

Installation

First remove existing grass and compact the sub-surface. Make sure the area is level before the turf is laid out. The turf will be delivered in 12' widths therefore any custom widths are to be cut on site. The Tee-Line Turf must be laid and positioned so that the nap of the fiber on all of the rolls are facing the same direction. The seams can be put together by sewing or using a seaming iron. Infill the turf with sand within 1/2" of the top of the turf. Add 1/4" of rubber to finish the infill process.

The final installation step is to nail (6" screw nail) the outside edge every 6"-12" depending on the curve. This will be covered with the material and/or sand and will not show.
